In the website you can read the full Minimap experience told by the editors; find links and photos to the places featured in the map; related blog posts; a mini-bio of the editors and the illustrators; and of course, a link to download and print your minimap.

We already have more than 20 minimaps ready to be downloaded and experienced. From some European capitals Madrid, London, Paris, Brussels, to Sao Paulo, Buenos Aires, San Francisco, Ubud and Sydney. IF YOU'RE EDITING

This is what we need from you:

- Name your map.
- Physical address, websitem opening times & prices of each spot.
- Introductory paragraph for your map: why this city, why these places, what is this map about? (This is used both in the paper map, a summarized version, and in the web, the extended one).
- Description of each place: why is worth going to that place?
- If you have photos of one or all of the places, it would be great so we can use them on the web and the Instagram. Is not mandatory though ;-)

IF YOU'RE ILLUSTRATING

Illustrations can be as free and imaginative as you wish, of course, as long as they can fit and be understood when printed in the top half of one A4 size sheet and use a circle as a base.

We will need:

- A A2 size hi-res CMYK image of the map.
- The editable (.ai or .psd) file of the map to extract an icon for the map cover and back.
- You can design your own cover if you want.

*Both designs and texts could be edited by the Minimaps team. The edited versions will be submitted to their creators for approval, of course. This rarely happens though!

As Minimaps is all about creating a personal conexion, we need a bit of info to create you a profile page:

- A mini-bio
- A profile photo of you traveling (min size: 980 x 620).
- Answer these questions please: Where do live? Where do you come from? Where do you (day)dream to go next? What do you like most about traveling? Is there a thing/ritual that you always have to do when you travel? (Throw coins in fountains, buy a cheap souvenir, eat local Chinese food, that sort of thing.)
