



UP & DOWN THE SEVEN HILLS

Lisbon is known as the city of the seven hills: A cidade das sete colinas. The Romans named Lisbon as Olissipo for its resemblance to the city of Rome which was also built over seven hills.

Throughout the city you can find several viewpoints and from each of them a unique view over it. This guide will help you find seven of those viewpoints, one for each hill.

1. CASTELO DE SÃO JORGE

You can easily spend the afternoon here between the Ruins of the former Royal Palace of the Alcáçova and the Camera Obscura, where you can discover the city in real time through a giant periscope.

2. MIRADOURO DE SANTA LUZIA

One of the most romantic terraces in Lisbon. Enjoy a panoramic view over Alfama which is one of the city's oldest neighbourhoods and over the Tagus River. It's a 15min walk up the hill from Rua Augusta or take the 28E Tram.

3. MIRADOURO DE SÃO PEDRO DE ALCÂNTARA

Perfect to have a drink at the Kiosk at the end of the day and go for dinner afterwards at Bairro Alto

4. MIRADOURO DA GRAÇA

Quiet in the morning but full of life in the afternoon. Popular spot for young people. One of the best places to see the sunset and enjoy a cold imperial (draft beer) in the open-air café.

5. MIRADOURO DE SANTA CATARINA

Known by locals as Adamastor, the mythical sea monster of 'Os Lusíadas' from Luís de Camões. Great view over the river and the 25 de Abril bridge.

6. CONVENTO DO CARMO

Beautiful view over Lisbon's rooftops, the Rossio Square, and the Santa Justa's Lift. A nice place to have breakfast, lunch or a coffee. Also you can visit the ruins of Convento do Carmo, destroyed during the 1755 earthquake.

7. JARDIM DO TOREL

Viewpoint surrounded by a romantic 19th century garden. You can drink a galão at the terrace and enjoy the view. If your feet hurt take the Lavra Lift to get here.
