You will notice that there are some things special to this place, like the use of local limestone, the balconies and the beautiful handles. Maybe this is why even residential buildings are also so pleasant to see. In this minimap you will find some of the city's most beautiful architectonic jewels, both historical and modern.

1. CITY GATE

Designed by Renzo Piano, is made of stone and there are two steel poles, 25m high. It is very evocative to cross it in the evening, walking on the illuminated bridge to enter in the city leaving behind the beautiful Triton's Fountain.

2. PARLIAMENT HOUSE

Part of Renzo Piano's "Valletta City Gate Project". It is a zero-emission building, consisting of two blocks connected by bridges.

3. PALAZZO FERRERIA

Designed by Architect Giuseppe Bonavia in the late 19th century. Is the second biggest one in Valletta after the Grandmaster's Palace. Perfect to admire the traditional closed balconies with wooden verandas.

4. NATIONAL LIBRARY OF MALTA

Neoclassical building designed by Polish Italian architects Stefano Ittar and his son Sebastiano. In the library it is possible to find archives, ancient manuscripts, incunabula and maps.

5. IS-SUQ TAL-BELT

The Is-Suq Tal-Belt or 'Covered Market' was designed by Hector Zimelli. In its three levels you will find the market, restaurants and bars and a great rooftop.

6. BASILICA OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

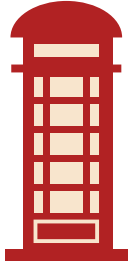
The skyline of Valletta is dominated by its dome. This neoclassical church was designed by Girolamo Cassar and built in 1570.

7. ST. PAUL'S PRO-CATHEDRAL

Designed by William Scamp in neoclassical style. Built between 1839-44. It resembles a Greek temple, with a portico with six columns with capitals of the Ionic order.
