1 LINARES PALACE

2 CASA DE LAS SIETE CHIMENEAS

3 ESLAVA THEATER

4 TIRSO DE MOLINA SUBWAY STATION

Skeletal remains such as skulls and jewellery from an ancient cemetery have been found in its construction. This has given rise to rumours of apparitions and strange phenomena and sounds.

5 CALLE DE LA CABEZA

In the 16th century, a priest's throat was slit by his servant, who fled to Portugal and returned to the scene many years later, convinced he had escaped, but he hadn't. The street sign is a summary of the story. Old emoji?

6 REINA SOFÍA ART MUSEUM

This building was a general hospital in 1566 and also served as a hostel and cemetery. During renovations, the mummies of three nuns were found and the presence of a ghost called Ataúlfo

7 FALLEN ANGEL FOUNTAIN
